

MAST Academy Shipshape Dress Code

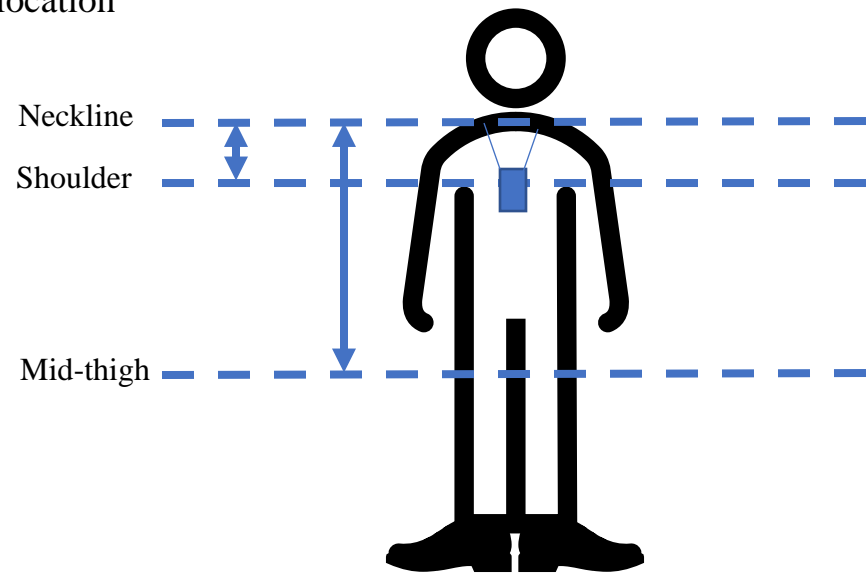
General Guidelines

All parts of this dress code apply to all students regardless of gender.

Every student is expected to dress appropriately and always positively represent MAST Academy.

Students must wear:

- Closed shoes with a solid toe and back, and heel no greater than 1-inch
- Tops with sleeves
- Appropriately fitted, not excessively tight or excessively loose, opaque clothing free of rips, tears, cut-outs, or fashion-holes that covers skin and undergarments from the neckline over the shoulder, the torso to the natural waistline, and pelvis and legs to at least the mid-thigh
- A school issued identification badge, in a visible location



MAST Academy Shipshape Dress Code

General Guidelines

The following items have been mutually agreed upon by the students, teachers, parents, administrators, and community partners in the MAST Academy EESAC to be inappropriate and not allowed:

- Clothing with obscene/profane/vulgar or sexually suggestive language/pictures or containing references to alcohol, drugs, tobacco, weapons, violence, gangs, or bullying
- Cut-off clothing or clothing with holes, cut outs, rips, or tears that make skin visible
- Clothing that is excessively tight, excessively loose, or transparent (includes pajamas, leggings, tights, or spandex-like fabric as sole covering of pelvis and legs)
- Sleeveless shirts, halter tops, tank tops, tube tops, spaghetti straps, or camisoles
- Blouses/shirts, pants, shorts that expose bare midriff or underclothes
- Open toe shoes, Crocs, backless shoes, sandals, shoes with cleats, shoes with a heel of more than 1-inch
- Sunglasses, hats, caps, visors, or any head attire that conceals identity
- Headphones, or earbuds while in the hallways or common areas
- Shorts, skirts, skorts, and dresses that are above the mid-thigh
- Any clothing or accessory determined by the staff and/or administration to distract other students/teachers from learning/teaching or to constitute a safety or health hazard to others and/or property

Individual classes/programs may implement additional dress code restrictions based on content, curriculum, special circumstances, and/or safety to life issues.

Deviation from the dress code requires approval by administration.

This dress code was approved by MAST Academy's EESAC in May 2022.

Middle School Students Grades 6-8

	Appropriate	Inappropriate (not an exhaustive list)
Tops	Royal blue or grey polo shirt with collar and school patch	Exposed midriff, translucency, sleeveless shirts, scoop necks, spaghetti straps, logos other than the school logo, sport jersey
Bottoms	Jeans - denim Slacks - khaki or navy in color Mid-thigh length or longer shorts, skirt, skorts – khaki or navy in color	Low-cut jeans, sweatpants, swimsuits, leggings, pajama pants, short-shorts, anything that does not cover the upper-thigh
Footwear	Closed shoes with a solid toe and back, and heel no greater than 1-inch	Open toe shoes, flip-flops, backless shoes, clogs, sandals, shoes with wheels (Heelys), convertible shoes such as Crocs, heel greater than 1-inch
Outerwear	Sweatshirts, sweaters, and jackets are to be worn over school uniform. Must be plain or have school logo. Belts and prescription glasses are permissible.	A shirt must be worn underneath jackets and sweaters. Hats, caps, visors, bandanas, any head attire that conceals identity, sunglasses, headphones or earbuds (while in the hallways or common areas)
Physical Education	School-approved navy-blue gym shorts with a MAST Academy T-shirt or solid white T-shirt. White socks with tennis shoes.	Students cannot wear P.E. uniform outside of P.E. class. All students must wear a top at all times unless engaged in water-based activities.
Spirit Day	Friday is School Spirit Day! Students may wear any MAST Academy club, team, or school organization shirt.	No school logos other than the MAST Academy logo as presented on items sold by or at the school.

High School Students Grades 9-12

	Appropriate	Inappropriate (not an exhaustive list)
Tops	Must cover at least from neckline to over the shoulder and torso to natural waistline	Exposed midriff, translucency, sleeveless shirts, scoop necks, spaghetti straps, halter tops, tank tops, camisoles
Bottoms	Must cover at least from natural waistline to mid-thigh	Low-cut jeans, pajama pants, swimsuits, short-shorts, anything that does not cover the upper-thigh, leggings, tights, or spandex-like fabric as sole covering of pelvis and legs
Footwear	Closed shoes with a solid toe and back, and heel no greater than 1-inch	Open toe shoes, flip-flops, backless shoes, clogs, sandals, shoes with wheels (Heelys), convertible shoes such as Crocs, heel greater than 1-inch
Outerwear	Sweatshirts, sweaters, and jackets are to be worn over a shirt. Belts and prescription glasses are permissible.	A shirt must be worn underneath jackets and sweaters. Hats, caps, visors, bandanas, any head attire that conceals identity, sunglasses, headphones or earbuds (while in the hallways or common areas)
Physical Education	School-approved navy-blue gym shorts with a MAST Academy T-shirt or solid white T-shirt. White socks with tennis shoes. School approved swimsuits will be required for water-based activities. Only a rash guard may be worn over a swimsuit while swimming. Swim goggles are optional but highly recommended. No cut-off clothing or just underwear allowed at any time for water-based activities. Swim caps are required if hair is shoulder length or longer.	Students cannot wear P.E. uniform or swimsuit outside of P.E. class. All students must wear a top at all times unless engaged in water-based activities.
Spirit Day	Friday is School Spirit Day! Students may wear any MAST Academy club, team, or school organization shirt.	No school logos other than the MAST Academy logo as presented on items sold by or at the school.
